Abair Liom: Lesson 24: Ag Péinteáil (Painting) Lth 118-123.

While schools are closed, Folens have opened up their resources to everyone. If you want to access this week's chapter on 'Painting' you can do so by following these steps.

- Go to www.folensonline.ie and click register
- Select Teacher
- Fill in a username, email and password
- For Roll Number use the code; Prim20

The kids should be able to navigate around the posteaer page by themselves. On this page the children can play games, listen to a story, listen to a catchy song and a poem. It is very interactive and the children have learnt some of the vocabulary already.

On page 120 look at the picture of the room in the house and fill in the missing word to finish the sentence. **Tolg** (couch), **bord** (table), **leaba** (bed), **leithreas** (toilet), **bosca** (box).

On page 121, your child can listen to the rólímirt being read aloud on the rolímirt section of the website and then match the picture to the correct emotion. **Fearg** (cross/angry), **eagla** (scared/frightened), **brón** (sad), **áthas** (happy).

On page 122, look at the pictures and answer the questions. **Cá bhfuil Mamaí?** (Where is Mammy?)

On page 123 there is a fun word search looking at words containing the sound 'o' and 'ó'. Ó makes the 'o' sound long. **Rothar**, **fón**, **tolg**, **rón**, **bróga**, **bosca**, **doras**, **cóta**.

The children always enjoy playing the interactive game 'Cartaí Meaitseála' (Memory), which will help to consolidate the vocabulary learnt.

Work It Out: Friday Tests week 16, 17, 18, 19, 20

Figure it Out: pgs 34, 39 and 41 **Addition and Subtraction of Tens and Units:** We have done a lot of work in tens and units over the year and we are now moving onto addition and subtraction of tens and units. This is a new topic but I know that you have seen it incidentally in Work it Out.

In the addition of tens and units, the rule to follow is **add the units first** and then add the tens, so for example:

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ +13 \\ \hline 25 \end{array}$$

Add the units first: $2+3=5$ and write the 5 on the units side. Then add the tens: $1+1=2$ and write the 2 on the tens side. So, $12+13 = 25$.

Subtraction is done the same way. **Subtract the units first** and then subtract the tens, so for example:

$$\begin{array}{r} 24 \\ -12 \\ \hline 12 \end{array}$$

Subtract the units first: $4-2=2$ and write the 2 on the units side. Then subtract the tens: $2-1=1$ and write the 1 on the tens side. So $24-12=12$

They will also hear the rólímirt on pg 127 being acted out (Don't worry about part c on pg 127)

On pg 128 you will see the words **Fíor nó Bréagach** (True or False). Look at the picture and read the sentence and write down fíor nó bréagach.

On pg 128 there is a fun activity 'Break the Code' which looks at words with the sounds 'a' and 'á'. 'Á' makes the 'a' sound long. **Cás, doras, áthas, grán rósta, lámh, hata, lampa, arán.**
